FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is Quiz Night?

2. Who will I see at Quiz Night?

3. What is the purpose of Quiz Night?

4. How is table seating coordinated? There are many options for seating:

- Organize your own table of 10
- Request to be seated with someone from your child’s grade or bus stop
- A table captain from each grade will help you find a team to join
- Create a partial table and we’ll help fill the rest.
- We will seat you with some really awesome people!

5. I heard the event is self catered, or “Think Ravinia.” What are my options for food?
