## SCHOOL UNIFORM REGULATIONS

All articles of clothing should be clearly marked in permanent ink with the student's name. The Schools cannot be responsible for unmarked clothing.

- Uniforms must be clean and without rips, tears, or holes.
- Clothes must fit properly -- no oversized or tight clothing, modest skirt and short lengths (no more than two inches above the knee).
- All shirts and blouses are to be tucked in at all times.
- No cargo pants or shorts (pants or shorts with exterior pockets) are allowed. "Docker style" pants for khakis and shorts are the allowed style.
- Sweaters may be monogrammed, but this is optional.
- The wearing of jewelry is not allowed, with the exception of religious medals, simple watches, one pair of small pierced posted earrings.
- Makeup, and hair that is dyed an unnatural color, are not allowed.
- Athletic shoes of any color may be worn at any time, except when directed by the Division Heads for special occasions (Masses, Prize Days, etc.) Lights and "heelies" are not permitted.
- If athletic shoes are not worn, shoes should be black, brown, or navy dress shoes with rubber, no-scuff soles. No heels in excess of one inch.
- If students do not wear athletic shoes to school, then they are expected to have shoes specifically for P.E. classes.
- Socks, tights, or leggings may be white, black, or navy. Socks may be over the ankle or knee socks. If leggings are worn, socks must also be worn.
- Belts may be any color. If pants have belt loops, a belt must be worn. Shirts must be tucked in if students are wearing pants or shorts.
- Hairstyles must be neat, clean, and well-groomed. Extreme hairstyles (mohawks, etc.) are not permitted. Facial hair is not permitted.
- All logo items are purchased through SchoolBelles.
- Uniform Guidelines may be amended by school administration at any time.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for all school events where the school uniform is not required. Events include performances by other students, concerts, plays, athletic award ceremonies, graduations, and religious ceremonies. Appropriate dress should be modest and does not include jeans, sweatpants, shorts, or tank tops.

## PRESCHOOL UNIFORM

- Navy polo dress with school logo
- Navy, elastic-waist pants
- Red polo shirt with school logo
- Navy sweater
- Navy school sweatshirt, ¾-zip
- Non-scuff, rubber-soled athletic shoes
- Preschool students may wear navy, elastic-waist shorts in September and May/June

## REGULAR UNIFORM

### Primary and Lower School (SK-5)

#### Sweater/Sweatshirt

- Optional navy sweater\*
- Optional uniform sweatshirt in navy from Schoolbelles

#### Blazer

- N/A

#### Ties

- Boys: red tie\* (*not required for SK*)

#### Shirt

- White, long- or short-sleeved cotton (or cotton blend) dress shirt, plain front.

#### Pants

- Khaki “Dockers” slacks
- Black Watch plaid slacks

#### Jumper\*\*

- PS: Box-pleated tunic (“princess” style) Black Watch plaid jumper
- LS: V-neck Black Watch plaid, pleated jumper

*\* Required for Formal Uniform days (Wednesday/Thursday and other days as instructed)*

*\*\* Fleece pants may be worn under the jumper when the weather is cold, before/after school and at recess only. No flannel pajamas or other sweatpants are allowed.*

### Middle School (6-8)

#### Sweater/Sweatshirt

- Optional navy sweater
- Optional uniform sweatshirt in navy from Schoolbelles

#### Blazer

- Girls: Classic full-length navy blazer (non-bolero) with Academy patch emblem\*
- Boys: Navy blazer with Hardey patch\*

#### Ties

- Girls: Optional red tie
- Boys: Red tie\* to be worn with blazer



**Shirt**

- White, long- or short-sleeved cotton (or cotton blend) dress shirt, plain front.

**Pants**

- Khaki “Docker style” slacks
- Black Watch plaid slacks

**Skirt\*\***

- Kick-pleat Black Watch plaid skirt, no more than two inches above the knee.

*\* Required for Formal Uniform days (Wednesday/Thursday and other days as instructed)*

*\*\* Fleece pants may be worn under the skirt when the weather is cold, before/after school and at recess only. No flannel pajamas or other sweatpants are allowed.*

## SUMMER UNIFORM

**Worn: September, May and June (SK-8 only)**

**Sweater/Sweatshirt**

- Optional uniform sweatshirt in navy from Schoolbelles

**Shorts**

- Navy walking shorts, not to be more than 2 inches above the knee, with or without cuffs. No cargo shorts.
- Belt if shorts have belt loops.

**Shirt**

- White, short-sleeved polo shirt, without logos, tucked in

## FORMAL WINTER UNIFORM

- Formal Uniform (Wednesdays, Thursdays, other days as instructed)
- Khaki or Black Watch pants OR Black Watch jumper/skirt
- White dress shirt
- If wearing pants, sweater (not sweatshirt) required in PS and LS
- Blazer required for MS
- Red tie required for boys (Grades 1-8), optional for MS girls

## **GYM UNIFORM**

### **SK-4**

- Regular school uniform is worn
- Shorts or leggings should be worn under jumpers for gym activities
- Athletic shoes with support, with non-scuff soles. May be worn in school, or may be a separate pair that students keep at school

### **Grades 5-8**

- Sacred Heart gym uniform (gray logo t-shirt and red logo shorts from School-belles)
- Athletic shoes with support, with non-scuff soles. May be worn in school, or may be a separate pair that students keep at school

## **OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS**

**Worn: First Friday of every month, excluding September, May, and June**

- No inappropriate messages.
- No ripped or torn clothing.
- No pajama pants unless approved by division head.
- Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- No clogs, backless shoes, or sandals
- Modest dress: no shoulders, stomachs, or thighs exposed
